## MERCED COUNTY FAIR LIVESTOCK CAMPING RULES

- As a courtesy and to maximize RV spaces, we will not allow the purchase of a RV space simply to park a car. If a space is purchased for parking a vehicle and a cancellation is required, we will withhold \$25.00 processing fee from the refund check.
- Each unit will be assigned a specific location for the week of the fair. There will be no changing.
- RV's may be brought in Saturday, 6/6/20, between the hours of 7:00 AM and 5:00 PM, or 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM and on Sunday, 6/7/20. RVs may be removed at anytime starting on Sunday, 6/14/20.
- All junior exhibitors staying on the fairgrounds campgrounds during fair week must stay in RVs or camper units in assigned spaces. Absolutely no exhibitor will be permitted to sleep in the barns or pitch a tent on the grounds.
- Each unit must have a responsible <u>ADULT</u> (21 years or over) supervising.
- Only exhibitors will be permitted to stay in the campgrounds. No visitors or friends will be permitted to stay with the exhibitors.
- There will be a 12:00 Midnight curfew for all exhibitors staying in the campgrounds. Camper areas are to be quiet after Midnight.
- Due to liability reasons, ATVs, motorcycles, quads or golf carts are allowed to be driven on the fairgrounds by authorized personnel and employees only. *Exhibitors are <u>not</u> allowed* to operate these types of vehicles on the grounds at anytime.
- Please be considerate of your neighbors. We ask that you run your generators with care.
- In order to facilitate our out of town guests, the Exhibitor must live outside a 15 mile radius of the fairgrounds in order to qualify for RV space.
- Vehicles with a valid RV/parking permit will be allowed to park next to the RV. You may pick up your parking permit at the Livestock office Saturday, 6/6/20 between 7:00 AM and 5:00 PM or Sunday, 6/7/20 between 7:00 AM and 5:00 PM.
- Any concerns should be brought to the attention of the Livestock Staff. The Livestock Superintendent reserves the right to have any RV removed should they not abide by the rules.
- Due to limited parking, each space is allowed their registered RV and only <u>one</u> authorized vehicle.
- Starting, Wednesday, June 10<sup>th</sup> you must enter the RV parking area from 9<sup>th</sup> & E Streets, (the back side of the lot). There will only be a walk through gate open on the G Street entrance.
